



Esperandieu Pierre, Campus Crusade's national director of Haiti said, "The smell of decomposing bodies and dead animals has literally filled the air of the city of Port-au-Prince. Everyone is trapped all over the place. People need water. They need food."

Global Aid Network (GAIN) is Campus Crusade for Christ's humanitarian aid ministry. Thankfully, we mobilized quickly, to feed and provided medical care to people in need. Since we already shipped a container with 100,000 meals, water filtration systems and medical supplies to Haiti in anticipation of the summer hurricane season.

For dozens of years, Haiti has been dependent on Christian missions organizations to supplement the Haitian



infrastructure with schools, orphanages and hospitals.

We are using ministry tools, including the Jesus Film, to meet the Haitians spiritual needs along with their physical needs. We will continue as opportunities arise. When the earth quaked and buildings collapsed, ministries like GAIN, Samaritans'

Purse, World Vision and other local partners were able to act quickly.

These groups are always in the country. They have strong relationships with the government officials. They know how to navigate the system to import aid. Groups like the Red Cross do not have these ongoing relationships; therefore, they get bogged down, resulting in a slower response during this critical time.
